

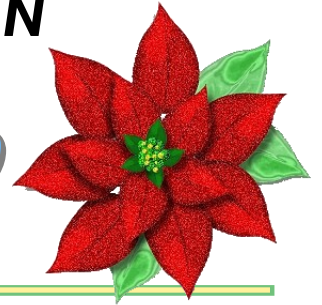
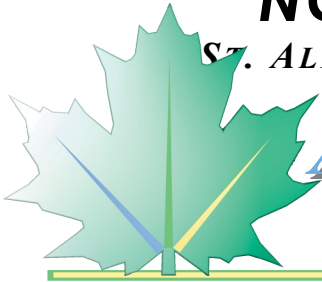

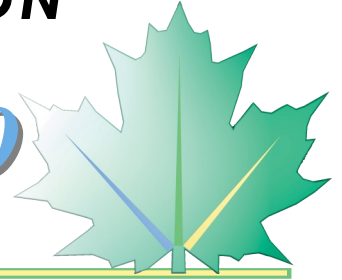

Our Mission To The Community

PEG TV is a non-profit corporation organized for the following purposes:

1. To enable, support, and promote the production and distribution of television programs by and for educational, charitable, social service, religious, governmental, electoral or other non-profit organizations; residents of, or members of a group which operates primarily within service area PEG TV.
2. To distribute these programs on its cable television channel(s) and other publicly accessible telecommunication network facilities, as it deems appropriate. These other distribution pathways may include, but are not limited to, closed circuit, common carrier, multi-channel microwave, satellite, telephone, videocassette, audio cassette, or broadcast television and radio.
3. To provide for the care and custody of equipment, facilities and programs owned or used by PEG TV.
4. To seek and receive grants from public and private sources in order to meet the expenses of the aforesaid purposes.
5. To exercise any other rights or responsibilities incidental to or associate with applicable law.
